Mark 8:11-21

Men love the darkness rather than Light because their deeds are evil- John 3:19-20

But even if our gospel is veiled, it is veiled to those who are perishing, whose minds the god of this age has blinded, who do not believe, lest the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine on them- 2 Corinthians 4:3-4

“Suzeteo”=

The Pharisees went out and immediately held counsel with the Herodians against him, how to destroy him- Mark 3:6

He is possessed by Beelzebul, and by the prince of demons he casts out the demons- Mark 3:22

And they said to Him, “By what authority are You doing these things? And who gave You this authority to do these things?”- Mark 11:28

“Peirazo”=

But that prophet or that dreamer of dreams shall be put to death, because he has spoken in order to turn you away from the LORD your God- Deuteronomy 13:1-5

Hypocrites! You know how to discern the face of the sky, but you cannot discern the signs of the times- Matthew 16:3

Blind guides, who strain out a gnat and swallow a camel!- Matthew 15:14

A wicked and adulterous generation seeks after a sign, and no sign shall be given to it except the sign of the prophet Jonah- Matthew 16:4

For as Jonah was three days and three nights in the belly of the great fish, so will the Son of Man be three days and three nights in the heart of the earth- Matthew 12:38-40
