Mark 9:1-13

“Apokaloupsis”=

And we all, with unveiled face, beholding the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from one degree of glory to another- 2 Corinthians 3:18

Woe is me! For I am lost; for I am a man of unclean lips, and I dwell in the midst of a people of unclean lips; for my eyes have seen the King, the Lord of hosts!- Isaiah 6:5

But if he will not hear, take with you one or two more, that ‘by the mouth of two or three witnesses every word may be established- Matthew 18:16

“Metamorphoo”=

For we did not follow cunningly devised fables when we made known to you the power and coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, but were eyewitnesses of His majesty- 2 Peter 1:16-18

He was transfigured before them. His face shone like the sun, and His clothes became as white as the light- Matthew 17:2

As He prayed, the appearance of His face was altered, and His robe became white and glistening- Luke 9:29

When Christ who is our life appears, then you also will appear with Him in glory- Colossians 3:4

And as we have borne the image of the man of dust, we shall also bear the image of the heavenly Man- 1 Corinthians 15:49

So also is the resurrection of the dead. The body is sown in corruption, it is raised in incorruption. It is sown in dishonor, it is raised in glory. It is sown in weakness, it is raised in power- 1 Corinthians 15:42-43

Then it happened, as they continued on and talked, that suddenly a chariot of fire appeared with horses of fire, and separated the two of them; and Elijah went up by a whirlwind into heaven- 2 Kings 2:11

And behold, two men talked with Him, who were Moses and Elijah, who appeared in glory and spoke of His decease which He was about to accomplish at Jerusalem- Luke 9:30-31

Then the cloud covered the tabernacle of meeting, and the glory of the LORD filled the tabernacle- Exodus 40:34-38

And when the disciples heard it, they fell on their faces and were greatly afraid- Matthew 17:6-7

When the voice had ceased, Jesus was found alone. But they kept quiet, and told no one in those days any of the things they had seen- Luke 9:36

But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth- Acts 1:8

One witness shall not rise against a man concerning any iniquity or any sin that he commits; by the mouth of two or three witnesses the matter shall be established- Deuteronomy 19:15

Therefore when Jesus perceived that they were about to come and take Him by force to make Him king, He departed again to the mountain by Himself alone- John 6:15

Hear me, O Lord, hear me, that this people may know that You are the Lord God, and that You have turned their hearts back to You again- 1 Kings 18:37
